Uso

Se usa para referirnos a **acciones que ocurrieron y terminaron en el pasado**.

I **lived** in Archidona for 18 years.

Suele ir acompañado de expresiones como **yesterday**, **last**, **..... ago** o también **fechas**.

We **went** to a restaurant **last night**.
